Hobart Airport Site Visit and Seminar


Wednesday, September 18

Join AIRAH for a site visit to Link Logistics at Hobart Airport, followed by a presentation on transcritical CO_2 .

Conducting the site visit will be Pieter Boon, M.AIRAH. Pieter has 20 years of experience in the refrigeration industry in a broad variety of fields and roles. Now working for Degree C, he is a project manager responsible for the design and construction of heavy commercial and industrial projects.

Following the site visit, a short presentation will take place at the Degree C office, which is not far from the airport. Topics to be covered will be:

- CO₂ refrigeration what's different, and what's the same?
- Why CO₂? Or why go for a natural refrigerant altogether?
- Why is Tasmania particularly suitable for transcritical CO₂?
- The workings of a transcritical CO₂ plant, and piping and instrumentation diagrams (P&ID) explained
- The Link Logistics project.
