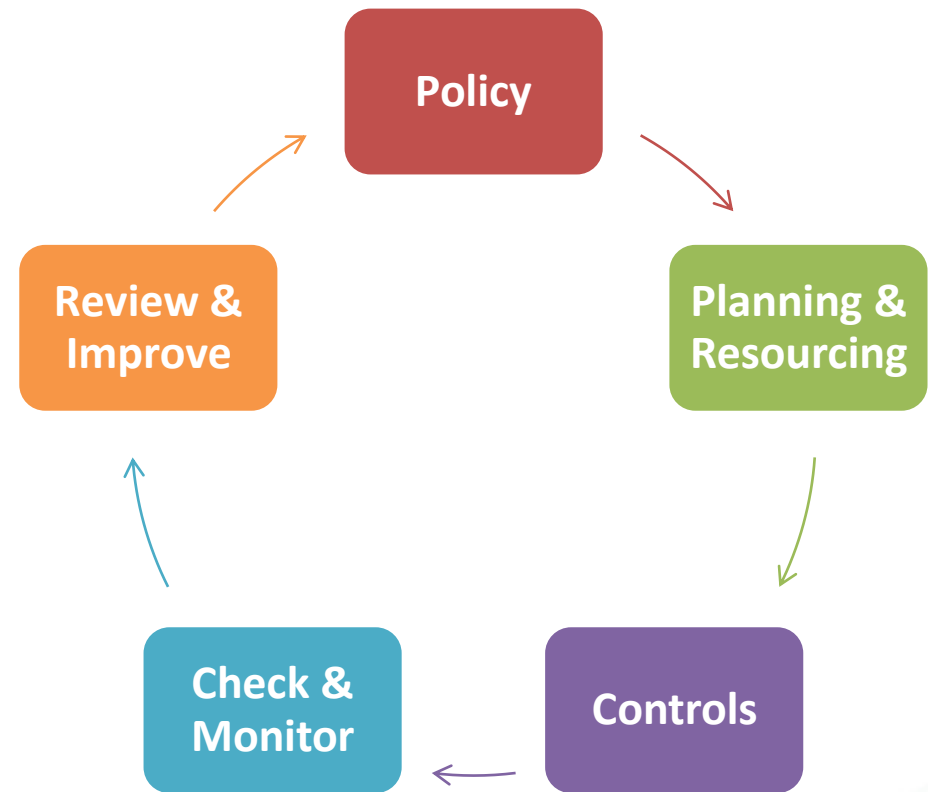

# What is a WHS Management System?

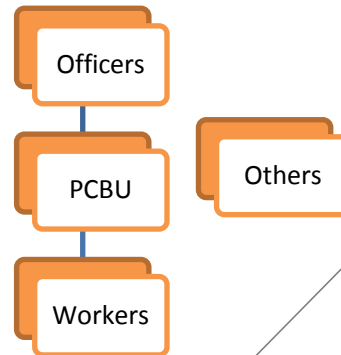
“The framework of processes and procedures used to ensure that an organization can fulfil all tasks required to achieve its objectives.”





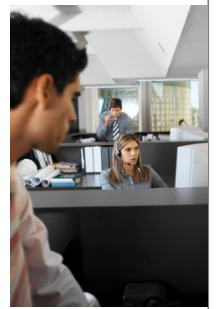
