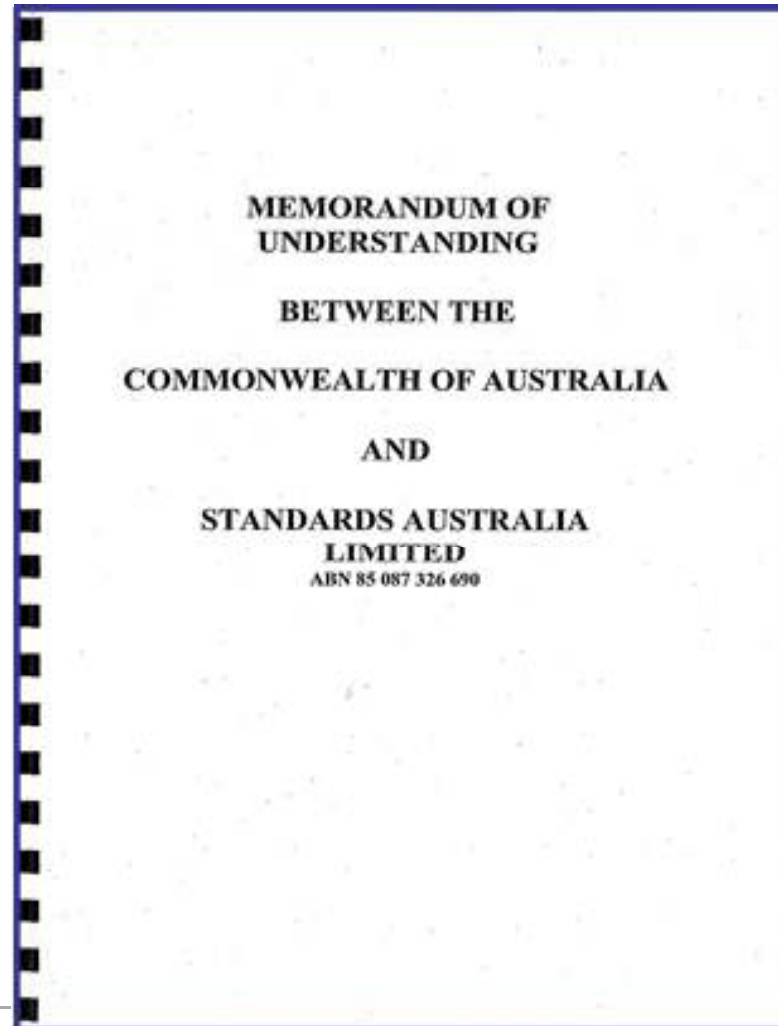

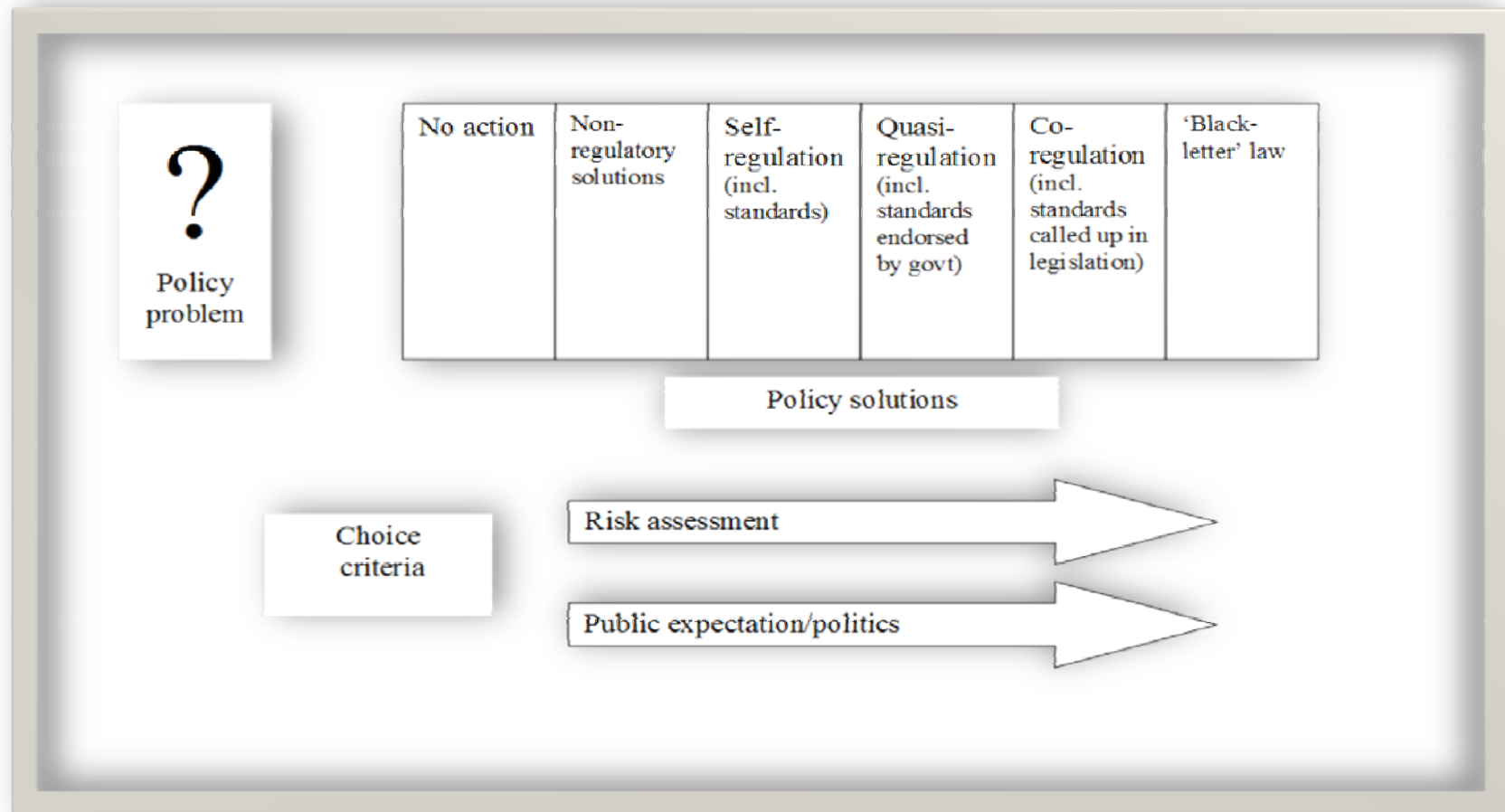
## Australia's National Standards Body
